About MSK

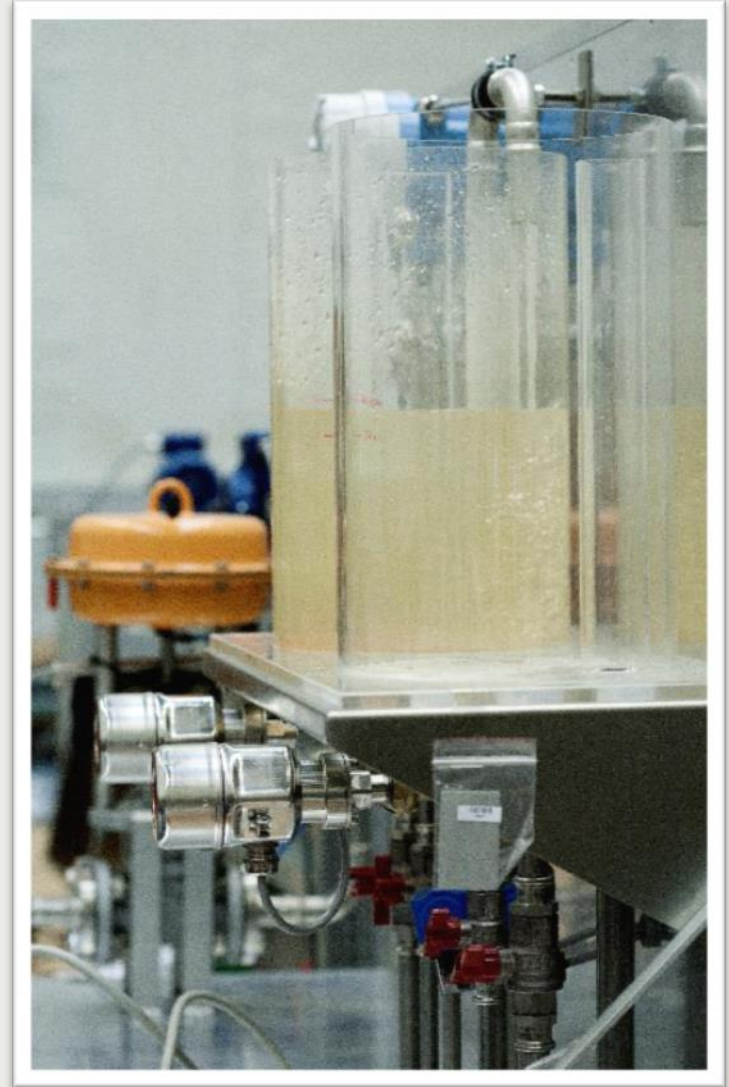
The Copenhagen School of Marine Engineering and Management Technology (MSK) is Denmark's oldest Marine Engineering School of six schools.
